

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SECTION B
SUPPLIES OR SERVICES AND PRICES/COSTS

B. 1 Contract Type

Contract Type

This is a single-award veteran owned small business firm-fixed-price (FFP) General Services Administration (GSA) supplies and services blanket purchase agreement (BPA) under GSA Schedule 76/SIN 760 2 to provide Library Management Support Services for the Department of Commerce (DOC), National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), National Environmental Satellite Data Information Services (NESDIS), Library and Information Services Division (LISD) as described in Section C, Statement of Work (SOW). This BPA doesn't obligate any funds. Services shall be ordered by issuance of individual FFP "Calls" by the Contracting Officer (CO). All "Calls" placed under this BPA are subject to the terms and conditions of the vendor's GSA contract and the clauses in this BPA. Upon mutual agreement of the parties, additional terms and conditions may be included in individual "Calls" against this BPA.

This BPA is pursuant to FAR Subpart 8.4 under the Federal Acquisition Regulation. The requirement is to provide DOC/NOAA/LISD Library Management Support Services. This contract consists of a period of performance from September 19, 2013 to September 18, 2018, which consists of a twelve- month base period and four twelve- month Option periods.

SECTION C
DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/WORK STATEMENT

C. 1 1352.237-71 SECURITY PROCESSING REQUIREMENTS - LOW RISK CONTRACTS (APR 2010)

(a) Investigative Requirements for Low Risk Contracts. All contractor (and subcontractor) personnel proposed to be employed under a Low Risk contract shall undergo security processing by the Department's Office of Security before being eligible to work on the premises of any Department of Commerce owned, leased, or controlled facility in the United States or overseas, or to obtain access to a Department of Commerce IT system. All Department of Commerce security processing pertinent to this contract will be conducted at no cost to the contractor.

(b) Investigative requirements for Non-IT Service Contracts are:

- (1) Contracts more than 180 days - National Agency Check and Inquiries (NACI)
- (2) Contracts less than 180 days - Special Agency Check (SAC)

(c) Investigative requirements for IT Service Contracts are:

- (1) Contracts more than 180 days - National Agency Check and Inquiries (NACI)
- (2) Contracts less than 180 days - National Agency Check and Inquiries (NACI)

(d) In addition to the investigations noted above, non-U.S. citizens must have a background check that includes an Immigration and Customs Enforcement agency check.

(e) Additional Requirements for Foreign Nationals (Non-U.S. Citizens). Non-U.S. citizens (lawful permanent residents) to be employed under this contract within the United States must have:

- (1) Official legal status in the United States;
- (2) Continuously resided in the United States for the last two years; and
- (3) Obtained advance approval from the servicing Security Officer in consultation with the Office of Security headquarters.

(f) DOC Security Processing Requirements for Low Risk Non-IT Service Contracts. Processing requirements for Low Risk non-IT Service Contracts are as follows:

(1) Processing of a NACI is required for all contract employees employed in Low Risk non-IT service contracts for more than 180 days. The Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) will invite the prospective contractor into e-QIP to complete the SF-85. The contract employee must also complete fingerprinting.

(2) Contract employees employed in Low Risk non-IT service contracts for less than 180 days require processing of Form OFI-86C Special Agreement Check (SAC), to be processed. The Sponsor will forward a completed Form OFI-86C, FD-258, Fingerprint Chart, and Credit Release Authorization to the servicing Security Officer, who will send the investigative packet to the Office of Personnel Management for processing.

(3) Any contract employee with a favorable SAC who remains on the contract over 180 days will be required to have a NACI conducted to continue working on the job site.

(4) For Low Risk non-IT service contracts, the scope of the SAC will include checks of the Security/Suitability Investigations Index (SII), other agency files (INVA), Defense Clearance Investigations Index (DCII), FBI Fingerprint (FBIF), and the FBI Information Management Division (FBIN).

(5) In addition, for those individuals who are not U.S. citizens (lawful permanent residents), the Sponsor may request a Customs Enforcement SAC on Form OFI-86C, by checking Block #7, Item I. In Block 13, the Sponsor should enter the employee's Alien Registration Receipt Card number to aid in verification.

(6) Copies of the appropriate forms can be obtained from the Sponsor or the Office of Security. Upon receipt of the required forms, the Sponsor will forward the forms to the servicing Security Officer. The Security Officer will process the forms and advise the Sponsor and the Contracting Officer whether the contract employee can commence work prior to completion of the suitability determination based on the type of work and risk to the facility (i.e., adequate controls and restrictions are in place). The Sponsor will notify the contractor of favorable or unfavorable findings of the suitability determinations. The Contracting Officer will notify the contractor of an approved contract start date.

(g) Security Processing Requirements for Low Risk IT Service Contracts. Processing of a NACI is required for all contract employees employed under Low Risk IT service contracts.

(1) Contract employees employed in all Low Risk IT service contracts will require a National Agency Check and Inquiries (NACI) to be processed. The Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) will invite the prospective contractor into e-QIP to complete the SF-85. Fingerprints and a Credit Release Authorization must be completed within three working days from start of work, and provided to the Servicing Security Officer, who will forward the investigative package to OPM.

(2) For Low Risk IT service contracts, individuals who are not U.S. citizens (lawful permanent residents) must undergo a NACI that includes an agency check conducted by the Immigration and Customs Enforcement Service. The Sponsor must request the ICE check as a part of the NAC.

(h) Notification of Disqualifying Information. If the Office of Security receives disqualifying information on a contract employee, the Sponsor and Contracting Officer will be notified. The Sponsor shall coordinate with the Contracting Officer for the immediate removal of the employee from duty requiring access to Departmental facilities or IT systems. Contract employees may be barred from working on the premises of a facility for any of the following reasons:

(1) Conviction of a felony crime of violence or of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.

(2) Falsification of information entered on security screening forms or of other documents submitted to the Department.

(3) Improper conduct once performing on the contract, including criminal, infamous, dishonest, immoral, or notoriously disgraceful conduct or other conduct prejudicial to the Government regardless of whether the conduct was directly related to the contract.

(4) Any behavior judged to pose a potential threat to Departmental information systems, personnel, property, or other assets.

(i) Failure to comply with security processing requirements may result in termination of the contract or removal of contract employees from Department of Commerce facilities or denial of access to IT systems.

(j) Access to National Security Information. Compliance with these requirements shall not be construed as providing a contract employee clearance to have access to national security information.

(k) The contractor shall include the substance of this clause, including this paragraph, in all subcontracts.

(End of Clause)

C. 2 1352.237-74 PROGRESS REPORTS (APR 2010)

The contractor shall submit, to the Government, a progress report every quarter month(s) after the effective date of the contract, and every quarter thereafter during the period of performance. The contractor shall deliver progress reports that summarize the work completed during the performance period, the work forecast for the following period, and state the names, titles and number of hours expended for each of the contractor's professional personnel assigned to the contract, including officials of the contractor. The report shall also include any additional information--including findings and recommendations -- that may assist the Government in evaluating progress under this contract. The first report shall include a detailed work outline of the project and the contractor's planned phasing of work by reporting period.

C. 3 Statement of Work

Statement of Work

LIBRARY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

NOAA/NESDIS/Library and Information Services Division (LISD)

I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

NOAA/NESDIS/ LISD is handling journal subscriptions for scientific journals, databases, and books in print, print plus online or online format in support of approximately 23 libraries nationwide for approximately 1,800 different titles (journals) to be acquired from foreign and domestic sources.

A. Definitions:

1. **Library.** The term Library, as used in this statement, refers to the NOAA Libraries.
2. **Delivery Order.** The term Delivery Order, as used in the SOW, means a request for delivery of goods or services under the terms and conditions of this contract. The delivery order provides accounting information and identifies the specific quantity of goods or services required.
3. **Subscription.** For the purpose of this contract, a Subscription is an agreement between the Contractor and a publisher to purchase or renew a serial or periodical, regardless of format, for a specific period of time for a specified price. Renewing subscriptions may require handling organizational memberships, late renewals and transfer renewals.
4. **Order/Bill Later.** The term Order/Bill Later refers to a publisher's pricing and distribution, which is irregular and unpredictable for a subscription requested. An order/bill later title is one that may not be published during the annual subscription period, and could be a delayed publication.
5. **Electronic Commerce.** The term Electronic Commerce, as used in the SOW, means a paperless process that integrates electronic data interchange (EDI), electronic mail (E-Mail), electronic bulletin boards, electronic funds transfer (EFT), and similar techniques into a comprehensive electronic-based system for accomplishing business transactions. The transactions are accomplished by electronically transferring formatted data between computers.
6. **Electronic Journals.** The term Electronic Journals, as used in the SOW, means a regular publication distributed in digital form via the World-Wide Web.
7. **Publisher Price.** The term Publisher Price, as used in this SOW, means the lowest established publisher list price for the given subscription period at the time of order acceptance by the publisher.

8. Service Fee. The term Service Fee refers to the Contractor's costs associated with the services provided in acquiring journal subscriptions. This includes, but is not limited to, work/services identified in Section C.2 of this document. The service fee is included in the price of the subscriptions.

II. GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. The Contractor shall provide for the placement of new and renewal orders for foreign and domestic journal subscriptions in print, print plus online and online formats over the life of the contract. The Contractor shall place all orders within five (5) working days from receipt of a delivery order from the Government.
- B. Whenever possible, the Contractor will assure continued access to previously subscribed content from publishers. While most large publishers do offer this to their customers, every effort must be made to ensure that access to content from subscriptions placed in previous years is honored. Resources must be accessible through a web-based interface and integrate with current NOAA systems and comply with security regulations. Accessibility should not require any client-installed software.
- C. The Contractor shall be responsible for prompt subscription payments to the publisher, and shall not invoice the Government prior to placing subscription orders. Invoice in electronic format shall be submitted to NOAA within one week of payment to the publisher.
- D. Most subscriptions to journals regardless of format run on the calendar year, from January to December. The Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring the timely delivery of all subscriptions to the correct locations within the publisher's agreed to time frames in accordance with commercial practices.
- E. The Contractor shall be responsible for processing all claims of missing or defective print issues within five (5) working days. It is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure replacement issues are received or a credit is issued to NOAA. While there are fewer problems with online subscription access and most of these issues are resolved between the publisher and the librarian, there will be instances when the Contractor will be required to provide payment and ordering information to the publisher to resolve the problem(s).
- F. The Contractor shall accept responsibility for continuation of service if existing subscription(s) are transferred from one publisher to another, including notification of new publisher and prompt accurate renewals to avoid either lapses or overlapping subscriptions. Furthermore the Contractor shall provide the new publisher with any online subscription information to prevent lapses in online access.
- G. The Contractor shall automatically supply all special issues, tables of contents, indexes, annual or other issues, and unnumbered supplements included in the basic subscription

price.

- H. The Contractor shall provide in electronic format (compatible with each Library's automated system, which is Sirsi, Voyager and any internal serial database) or by e-mail, information relating to Library orders.
- I. The Government reserves the right to cancel an ordered subscription at any time dependent upon the individual publisher's policy of cessations and refunds. The Contractor shall credit to the Government any refunds due to the Government for cancelled subscriptions.
- J. The Government reserves the right to add a subscription at any time depending upon the individual publisher's policy of starting new subscriptions. The Contractor shall provide subscription adjustment so that all new subscriptions, to the maximum extent possible, expire during the same month as all other ordered subscriptions.
- K. The Contractor shall provide the services as outlined above for each subscription placed up to the receipt of the last issue. At the completion of the contract, information including lists of titles shall be made available to each library in electronic format.
- L. The Contractor shall provide an electronic journal management services that will allow libraries to:
 - 1. Combine usage statistics, subscription details and price information;
 - 2. Counter complaint reporting functionality to analyze electronic resources by package or individual titles;
 - 3. Accurate price-per-use information to determine the return-on-investment for every e-journal for acquisition and renewal;
 - 4. An impact factor analysis tool for gauging the effectiveness of a title over a three-year period.
- M. The Contractor shall provide an electronic journal service to handle electronic journal management needs. This will improve efficiency by controlling e-journal registration from one place, control collection with coverage data, access rights, and license terms.
- N. The Contractor shall provide ability to integrate with online reference services that offers the Libraries access to full text databases as well as third-party (licensed) abstracting and indexes.
- O. The Contractor shall provide a web-based service, which will allow the Libraries access to table of contents, abstracts, and full text for electronic journals available on subscription.
- P. The Contractor shall provide an A-to-Z locator tool enabling libraries to market and promote e-resources to end users by providing a complete and comprehensive list.

- Q. The Contractor shall provide federated search capability to enable libraries to link to other journal subscriptions from A-to-Z locator which will result in patrons being able to search any or all of a library's databases simultaneously through a single interface.
- R. The Contractor shall provide program for managing and sharing research papers, discovering research data and collaborating online.
- S. The Contractor shall provide a document delivery service if a library was to need an article quickly from a journal not subscribed by anyone in NOAA.
- T. The Contractor shall also provide ability to provide subscriptions to electronic book collections from some of the world's most renowned STM publishing houses representing a broad spectrum of subject categories via ownership and subscription models.
- U. The Contractor shall serve as an intermediary between the Libraries and other publishers or vendors in the establishment of consortiums for electronic publications.

III. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, SPECIFIC

A. ORDERING

1. GENERAL ORDERING INFORMATION PROVIDED BY CONTRACTOR.

For journal publication not listed in the Contractor's database, the Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining and providing the necessary ordering information to the Library requesting the publication(s). If a Library wishes to order said publication, the Contractor shall provide the ordering service.

2. AGENCY SPECIFIC INFORMATION PROVIDED BY CONTRACTOR.

a. SUBSCRIPTION ORDER LISTS.

The Contractor shall provide a subscription order list (quote) depicting all orders placed during the previous fiscal year for each Library address on or before June 10th of each service year in order to assess their subscription expenditures for the fiscal year. The Contractor shall provide firm-fixed prices on the subscription order list based on the request of each Library. The Contractor's first year subscription order list shall be based upon the titles per library. Prices shall include a current or estimated publisher's price for each title. Each Library shall place delivery orders when actual publisher's prices and service charges have been communicated and accepted by the individual Library.

The list shall be in electronic format and shall be sorted alphabetically by title and shall contain at least the following:

- Complete billing and shipping addresses
- Account number chargeable, both Contractor account number and NOAA and other libraries internal numbers, including the prior year delivery order and organization code; prior year delivery order and NOAA organizational code shall be provided by NOAA.
- Title
- ISSN
- ISSN
- Format -- electronic or print
- Contractor Title Code or Number, if used
- Quantity
- Subscription period
- New, renewal, subscription added or transfer renewal
- Contractor's price
- Frequency

- b. The NOAA Central Library, located in Silver Spring, MD, will place orders for with the Contractor and the NOAA Seattle Regional Library in Seattle, WA; the NOAA Miami Regional Library and the NOAA National Hurricane Center (NHC) Library, both located in Miami, FL, as well as the NOAA Betty Petersen Library in College Park, MD. Other participating Libraries will place their own orders with the Contractor. Additional Libraries within and outside of NOAA, may be added to the list of authorized libraries to place orders under this contract.

Honolulu, HI 96822

The delivery order provides accounting information and identifies the specific quantity of goods or services required. All subscriptions shall be placed by the Contractor within five (5) working days of receipt of a delivery order and the authorization by the librarian.

3. ORDER/BILL LATER PRICES

When the publisher's pricing and distribution is irregular and unpredictable for a subscription requested, the Contractor shall have the option of designating the subscription as an Order/Bill Later. The Contractor shall provide each Library with the current price when it becomes available. After being given the price, the Library must agree in writing (by e-mail) to accept or reject the order. If the Library agrees to order the subscription, the Contractor shall place the order within five (5) working days from the date of notification provided by the Government to the Contractor, and invoice the Library for this item. At the expiration date of this contract, the Contractor shall provide each Library with a detailed list, in paper or electronic format as specified by the Library, of any outstanding Order/Bill Later titles.

IV. ANNUAL RENEWAL PROCESS

A. INITIAL YEAR.

For the initial subscription service to be ordered in the base year of the contract, each Library anticipates ordering those items. However, the Government will not be obligated to purchase anything beyond those titles.

B. OPTION YEARS.

For each library the Contractor shall combine its previous year's order with follow-on orders to produce an annual renewal list of all subscriptions. The list shall be separated by shipping addresses, arranged in alphabetical order by title, and include current or

estimated publisher prices. The annual list shall be sent to each Library for review on or before June 10th of each year. Each Library within its own time frame will prepare its order to submit to the Acquisitions and Grants Office (AGO) in Silver Spring, MD. AGO will issue the delivery order for the Library to the Contractor.

V. SPECIAL ORDERS

A. RUSH ORDERS.

Each Library may place rush orders at no additional service charge. The Contractor shall place a rush order by the following work day of receipt of the delivery order. It is estimated that no more than 20 rush orders will be requested during a contract year.

B. OTHER SPECIAL ORDERS.

Other special orders at no additional service charge may include, but not limited to:

- back issues (including titles not subscribed for under this contract)
- added copy subscriptions
- special issues
- indexes
- unnumbered supplements not included in the basic subscription
- sample copies of publications

The Contractor shall place the above listed special orders within five (5) working days from receipt of a delivery order.

VI. FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

If a refund has been requested by a Library, the Contractor shall provide written evidence of attempts to secure the credit to the requesting Library in its quarterly report. Credits shall be documented by a numbered and dated credit memorandum with the Contractor's next invoice including at least the following information:

- Delivery order number
- Title
- Reason for the refund
- Amount of refund

Each Library shall have the choice of either using the credit to offset charges of the specific delivery order, or requesting that a refund check be sent to the specific Library.

VII. PROBLEM RESOLUTION

A. PROBLEMS.

Problems may include, but are not limited to:

- incorrect shipping addresses
- incorrect titles
- incorrect format
- invoicing discrepancies
- missing issues
- mutilated or defective issues
- lapsed subscriptions
- duplicate issues
- authentication problems
- access issues
- licensing issues

B. NOTIFICATION.

As problems are identified, each Library shall notify the Contractor of these problems and send any available documentation to assist in the problem resolutions. The Contractor may also receive notification of these problems directly from the publisher in which case the Contractor shall notify the library.

C. RESOLUTION.

The Contractor shall handle all correspondence with publishers to resolve:

1. Invoicing discrepancies and other publisher's errors and problems.

When possible, the Contractor shall identify and resolve publisher's errors and problems without the involvement of the Library staff. The Library shall provide documentation to assist the Contractor when necessary.

2. Claims for missing or defective issues.

The Contractor shall accept requests for missing, defective or mutilated issues by e-mail, facsimile, and telephone.

The Contractor shall process requests for missing, mutilated, or defective issues within five (5) working days after notification by the Library and shall obtain replacement copies. These issues shall be provided at no cost to the Government as part of the re-ordered subscription unless directed otherwise in a delivery order.

3. Lapse and duplicate subscriptions.

For subscriptions which have lapsed and are subsequently re-ordered, the Contractor shall provide proof of payment to publishers in order to get subscription reinstated

immediately and provide all back issues at no cost to the Government as part of the re-ordered subscription unless directed otherwise in a delivery order.

Duplicate subscriptions placed by the Contractor in error shall be extended or deleted based upon the publisher's policy.

4. Shipping Address Changes.

Following notification by a Library of a change in a shipping address, the Contractor shall change its records and shall notify publishers within five (5) working days.

5. Online subscription.

The Contractor shall resolve problems arising from ordering online subscriptions with publishers. These include but are not limited to ensuring the correct online tier has been ordered and invoice discrepancies.

6. Authentication, access, and other online issues.

The Contractor shall also resolve problems Libraries experience with e-resources using the Contractor's electronic journal service. These problems include but are not limited to broken links, IP and/or username/password problems, losing access, and licensing issues.

D. REPORTS TO THE LIBRARY.

1. The Contractor shall be responsible for reporting to each Library the progress, the procedures and the status of all problem resolutions.
2. The Contractor shall provide quarterly listings to each Library of all outstanding requests and any responses received from the publishers.
3. The Contractor shall provide within five (5) working days current status reports on individual claims and problems when requested by the Library staff.

VIII. MANAGEMENT REPORTS

A. Reports and Lists:

The Contractor shall provide, in printed or electronic format, to each Library upon request the following management reports and lists:

1. A listing of titles sorted alphabetically showing titles billed versus those not billed, as well as any changes in the publisher's price on bill later items. This list shall be provided quarterly.

2. The Contractor shall provide a ship-to listing with complete addresses twice per Government fiscal year.
3. The Contractor shall provide subscription status information, which includes any subscription irregularities or changes to each library.
4. The Contractor shall provide an information bulletin updating the latest known information on various serial titles. This bulletin shall be available quarterly.
5. The Contractor shall merge the holdings lists of journal titles of two or more libraries, upon their request, to produce a combined Union list with full cross-references. The Contractor shall enter additional information provided by each Library to be included in the union list. The Union List of journal titles shall include at least the current subscriptions ordered through the Contractor.
6. The Contractor shall provide library management reports. The reports shall contain all or part of the following information as specified by the requesting Library:
 - a. Title
 - b. Ship-to address
 - c. Bill-to address
 - d. ISSN
 - e. EISSN
 - f. Format – electronic or print
 - g. Contractor title code or number, if used
 - h. Quantity
 - i. Subscription period
 - j. Contractor's price
 - k. Frequency
 - l. Bibliographic status of titles
 - m. Local title information, up to 80 characters
 - n. Title page and index availability
 - o. Special ordering information

The Contractor shall have the capability of sorting, subtotaling, and totaling the reports by any of the above listed fields. These reports shall be available quarterly.

7. The Contractor shall provide financial summary reports listing, by Government fiscal year or other ordering period, all contractor instigated credit or debit invoices to each Library. This report shall include invoice number, dollar amount, and service charge amount for each action. This report shall be available quarterly.

IX. ELECTRONIC AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ACCESSIBILITY (Section 508)

Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794d), as amended by the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, and the Architectural and Transportation Barriers

Compliance Board Electronic and Information (EIT) Accessibility Provisions (36 CFR part 1194), require that, unless an exception applies, all EIT products and services developed, acquired, maintained, or used by any Federal department or agency permit:

X. MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

A. ACCOUNT REPRESENTATIVE.

For each Library, the Contractor shall provide a customer representative who has the authority to resolve problems arising in the NOAA account. The customer representative must be available Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. EST/EDT, except Federal holidays.

B. ORIENTATION/TRAINING/MANUALS.

The Contractor shall provide orientation/training manuals for its services to each Library. Assistance shall include, but not be limited to, instructions on the completion of any Contractor-furnished forms and online access to and retrieval of information. Assistance shall be provided at the time of the award, when the Contractor changes procedures, or when the Library assigns new staff to the function. There shall be no charge for the orientation, training and/or manuals.

C. PUBLISHER'S PRICES.

The Contractor shall submit with all invoices, publisher invoices or other documentation acceptable to each library to verify subscription costs of the Contractor being charged to the Government.

G. 1 1352.201-70 CONTRACTING OFFICER'S AUTHORITY (APR 2010)

The Contracting Officer is the only person authorized to make or approve any changes in any of the requirements of this contract, and, notwithstanding any provisions contained elsewhere in this contract, the said authority remains solely in the Contracting Officer. In the event the contractor makes any changes at the direction of any person other than the Contracting Officer, the change will be considered to have been made without authority and no adjustment will be made in the contract terms and conditions, including price.

(a) The contractor shall assign to this contract the following key personnel:

(b) The contractor shall obtain the consent of the Contracting Officer prior to making key personnel substitutions. Replacements for key personnel must possess qualifications equal to or exceeding the qualifications of the personnel being replaced, unless an exception is approved by the Contracting Officer.

(c) Requests for changes in key personnel shall be submitted to the Contracting Officer at least 15 working days prior to making any permanent substitutions. The request should contain a detailed explanation of the circumstances necessitating the proposed substitutions, complete resumes for the proposed substitutes, and any additional information requested by the Contracting Officer. The Contracting Officer will notify the contractor within 10 working days after receipt of all required information of the decision on substitutions. The contract will be modified to reflect any approved changes.

- Veteran's Day

(b) In addition to the days designated as holidays, the Government observes the following days:

- Any other day designated by Federal Statute
- Any other day designated by Executive Order
- Any other day designated by the President's Proclamation

(c) It is understood and agreed between Government and the Contractor that observance of such days by Government personnel shall not otherwise be a reason for an additional period of performance, or entitlement to compensation except as set forth within the contract. If a Contractor believes that an unplanned absence impacted the price or period of performance they should notify the Contracting Officer of the changed condition and submit a claim for equitable adjustment (see FAR 52.233.1)

(d) Nothing in this clause abrogates the rights and responsibilities of the parties relating to "stop work" provisions as cited in other sections of this award.

(e) The Contractor shall comply with the aforementioned Government holidays and any other day designated by Federal Statute, Executive Order, or Presidential proclamation; therefore, the Government offices are closed to the Contractor's staff on the day(s) these holidays are observed. In addition, work shall not be required of the Contractor when Federal employees are released from work early due to inclement weather conditions or emergencies or when Federal offices are closed due to inclement weather conditions or emergencies (status available at <http://www.opm.gov/status/>). The COR will notify the Contractor when early release of Federal employees has been authorized.

The following provisions and clauses apply to this acquisition and shall be included in the award document and shall be considered when developing a quotation. Formatting may differ in the BPA/Call award.

INVOICE INSTRUCTIONS

SUBMITTAL OF INVOICES

The Contractor shall prepare and submit an invoice to the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative for approval. All payments shall be submitted by the 10th day of the subsequent month.

To constitute a proper invoice, the Contractor's invoice shall be prepared in accordance with, and contain all elements specified in, the paragraph entitled "Contractor's Invoice" of the applicable prompt payment provision of the contract (e.g., FAR 52.232-25 Prompt Payment, FAR 52.232-26 Prompt Payment for Fixed-Price Architect Engineer Contracts, or FAR 52.232-27 Prompt Payment for Construction Contracts). For contracts and orders for commercial items and services, paragraph (g) of FAR 52.212-4 entitled "Invoices" applies.

If the invoice does not comply with the applicable prompt payment provision of the contract, it will be returned to the Contractor within seven (7) days after the date the designated office received the invoice, with a statement as to the reasons why it is not a proper invoice.

- a. Payment will be based on receipt of a proper invoice and satisfactory contract performance and guidelines in FAR 32.9, Prompt Payment. The Contractor shall provide two original copies of each invoice for work that is performed directly to the Contracting Officer Representative (COR) identified in CAR Clause 1352.201-72.

PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS

Interim and final evaluations of Contractor performance will be prepared on this contract in accordance with FAR 42.15. The final performance evaluation will be prepared at the time of completion of work. In addition to the final evaluation, at least one interim evaluation will be prepared. Interim and final evaluations will be provided to the Contractor as soon as practical after completion of the evaluation. The Contractor will be permitted thirty (30) days to review the document and to submit additional information or a rebutting statement. If agreement cannot be reached between the parties, the matter will be referred to an individual one level above the Contracting Officer, whose decision will be final. Copies of the evaluations, Contractor responses, and review comments, if any, will be retained as part of the contract file, and may be used to support future award decisions.

NONPERSONAL SERVICES

- a. Pursuant to FAR 37.1, no personal services shall be performed under this contract. All work requirements shall flow only from the Project Officer to the Contractor's Project Manager. No Contractor employee will be directly supervised by the Government. All individual Contractor employee assignments, and daily work direction, shall be given by the applicable Contractor employee supervisor. If the Contractor believes any Government action or communication has been given that would create a personal services relationship between the Government and any Contractor employee, the Contractor shall promptly notify the Contracting Officer of this communication or action.
- b. Pursuant to FAR 7.5, the Contractor shall not perform any inherently Governmental actions under this contract. No Contractor employee shall hold him or herself out to be a Government employee, agent, or representative. No Contractor employee shall state orally or in writing at any time that he or she is acting on behalf of the Government. In all communications with third parties in connection with this contract, Contractor employees shall identify themselves as Contractor employees and specify the name of the company for which they work. In all communications with other Government Contractors in connection with this contract, the Contractor employee shall state that they have no authority to in any way change the contract and that if the other Contractor believes this communication to be a direction to change their contract, they should notify the Contracting Officer for that contract and not carry out the direction until a clarification has been issued by the Contracting Officer.
- c. The Contractor shall ensure that all of its employees working on the BPA/Call are informed of the substance of this article. Nothing in this article shall limit the Government's rights in any way under the other provisions of the contract, including those related to the Government's right to inspect and accept the services to be performed under this BPA/Call. The substance of this article shall be included in all subcontracts at any tier.

"Contingent fee," as used in this clause, means any commission, percentage, brokerage, or other fee that is contingent upon the success that a person or concern has in securing a Government contract.

"Improper influence," as used in this clause, means any influence that induces or tends to induce a Government employee or officer to give consideration or to act regarding a Government contract on any basis other than the merits of the matter.

"Prime contract," as used in this clause, means a contract or contractual action entered into by the United States for the purpose of obtaining supplies, materials, equipment, or services of any kind.

"Prime Contractor" as used in this clause, means a person who has entered into a prime contract with the United States.

"Prime Contractor employee," as used in this clause, means any officer, partner, employee, or agent of a prime Contractor.

"Subcontract," as used in this clause, means a contract or contractual action entered into by a prime Contractor or subcontractor for the purpose of obtaining supplies, materials, equipment, or services of any kind under a prime contract.

"Subcontractor," as used in this clause,

(1) means any person, other than the prime Contractor, who offers to furnish or furnishes any supplies, materials, equipment, or services of any kind under a prime contract or a subcontract entered into in connection with such prime contract, and

(2) includes any person who offers to furnish or furnishes general supplies to the prime Contractor or a higher tier subcontractor.

"Subcontractor employee," as used in this clause, means any officer, partner, employee, or agent of a subcontractor.

(b) The Anti-Kickback Act of 1986 (41 U.S.C. 51-58) (the Act), prohibits any person from--

(1) Providing or attempting to provide or offering to provide any kickback;

(2) Soliciting, accepting, or attempting to accept any kickback; or

In either case, the Prime Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer when the monies are withheld.
