





SUBJECT: Mandatory Use of NOAALink Program and Contracts
for Information Technology Products and Services

Please Distribute Broadly

The Office of the Chief Information Officer, Acquisition and Grants Office, and Office of the Chief Financial Officer have committed to achieve savings in the procurement and provisioning of information technology (IT) products and services. One way NOAA can achieve substantial savings is to standardize and consolidate IT purchases. Analysis has indicated NOAA is repeatedly paying too much when purchasing similar IT products and services across the bureau. Duplicative purchases represent unacceptable inefficiencies and opportunities for dollar savings. NOAA must benefit from standardization and consolidation of similar products and services in order to realize savings. Therefore, a new program and set of contracts entitled NOAALink shall be used to procure all infrastructure IT products and services. IT Infrastructure is defined as all common, widely used, or enterprise level services, functions or systems that indirectly serve mission activities. IT Infrastructure provides general organizational, management, and administrative computing and communications capability and services. This infrastructure includes and is not limited to: IT security; data and voice networks; end-user workstations; office automation hardware and software; enterprise messaging and collaboration; help desks, and administrative systems.
